5. Commit to a path of life-long learning, believing there is more value in questioning than in absolutes.

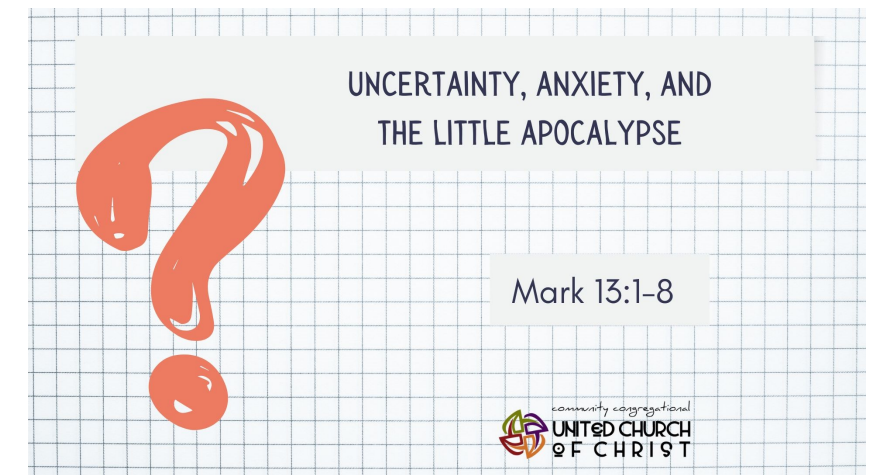
